The FLY Statewide High School Spring Tour is a dynamic theatrical presentation that uses poetry, music and drama to communicate the importance of being financially literate and fiscally responsible.

The response to the FLY Tour was so overwhelmingly positive that it is now an annual event that takes place in the Spring.
