

The clock is ticking...will you be ready?

The ED Form 799 is retiring October 1st!!

Are you ready for the NEW and IMPROVED Lender Reporting System (LaRS)?

With the LaRS production date of October 1st fast approaching, it is more important than ever to submit your Lender Application Process (LAP), Organization Participation Agreement (OPA), and Security Form. Remember, all forms must be submitted by 9/13 in order to have access to LaRS on 10/1. If you miss this deadline, you risk delaying your access to the new LaRS system, and may ultimately delay the submission of your quarterly student loan portfolio data.

Still not sure how to access LAP and the OPA? Completing your LAP and OPA is as easy as 1...2...3! Check out the three steps below and don't delay another day!

- □ Complete the LAP application on-line at <u>www.fp.ed.gov/PORTALSWebApp/fp/fms.jsp</u>. The LAP allows lenders and servicers to verify and update their demographic information. The LAP can be completed until September 13, 2002, but we strongly advise that sooner is better than later.
- □ Complete and mail the attached **OPA** to FSA. Once the OPA is completed and sent to FSA, 'wet' signatures are no longer required on each electronic submission. The OPA is also available at www.fp.ed.gov/fp/docs/larsopafinal01.doc.
- Complete and mail to FSA the attached Financial Management System (FMS) Security
 Form. This document identifies the INDIVIDUALS who will actually be gaining access to
 FMS and using the LaRS application. The FMS Security Form can also be obtained at
 www.fp.ed.gov/fp/docs/SecurityForm.doc.
