With the Commissioner's approval, the Board of Regents makes the following determinations for the GO Grant for the 2011-2012 academic year.

1. No changes to the eligibility framework. (Methodology in awarding the Louisiana Go Grant will remain the same as in 2010-2011. See Student Financial Aid Bulletin S2010-04, dated July 6, 2010.)
2. Annual award amounts for 2011-2012: \$1,000 fulltime, \$500 halftime, \$250 less than halftime.
3. Institutions will be given an annual allocation amount using the same methodology as last year. (2011-2012 Go Grant Allocation table is included).
4. The annual allocation will be used for fall, winter, and spring, with no plans to fund summer awards.
5. Due to legislative reporting requirements, it is necessary to institute a fall billing deadline of **November 1, 2011** (fall billing corrections deadline, November 16) and a winter billing deadline of **January 17, 2012** (winter billing corrections deadline, February 1). The fall and winter deadlines will also allow LOSFA and Board of Regents to better estimate funding availability for subsequent semesters/terms.
6. Late billings for fall, winter and spring **will not** be allowed. In the event of a reallocation of unused funds, the school(s) receiving the reallocated funding will be provided with a deadline to expend the reallocated dollars.
7. After the spring billing deadline, **March 24, 2012**, (spring billing corrections deadline, April 11), unused funds will be reallocated. Reallocations will be made to institutions to award to students enrolled in the fall and continued to spring or enrolled in the spring who were eligible for but did not receive a Go Grant because the institution used its full annual allocation.
8. Institutions should make awards according to their defined priority process. It is the general philosophy of the Board of Regents that the grant is awarded to those students with the most need. The Board of Regents will work with LOSFA and the financial aid professionals to develop a statewide priority process to be in place for the 2012-13 academic year.
