Scholarship/Grant Programs (LAC 28:IV.1805)

The Louisiana Student Financial Assistance Commission (LASFAC) is exercising the emergency provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act [R.S. 49:953(B)] to amend and re-promulgate the rules of the Scholarship/Grant programs (R.S. 17:3021-3025, R.S. 3041.10-3041.15, and R.S. 17:3042.1.1-3042.8, R.S. 17:3048.1, R.S. 56:797.D(2)).

This rulemaking amends Section 1805 of LASFAC's Scholarship/Grants rules for the Chafee Educational and Training Voucher Program to provide that a student must be ages 16-21 to be eligible for the program.

The proposed rule has no known impact on family formation, stability, or autonomy, as described in LSA-R.S. 49:972. The proposed rule will have no adverse impact on small businesses as described in LSA-R.S. 49:965.2 *et seq*. The proposed rulemaking will have no impact on poverty as described in LSA-R.S. 49:973. Part IV. Student Financial Assistance—Higher Education Scholarship and Grant Programs

Chapter 18. Chafee Educational And Training Voucher Program

§1805. Eligibility

- A. To establish eligibility, a student must:
- 1. Be ages 4516 to 21, except that a student who was participating in the Chafee ETV Program at age 21 may continue to receive ETVs until he attains the age of 23; and
- 2. Be in the foster care system, or aged out of the foster care system, or was under Legal Guardianship, or was in the foster care system or under Legal Guardianship and was adopted after age 16; and
 - 3. Be enrolled in postsecondary education; and
- 4. Annually complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
