TOPICS ADDRESSED DURING THE FLY TOUR INCLUDE LOSFA-ADMINISTERED COLLEGE ACCESS PROGRAMS, FAFSA COMPLETION, DOCUMENT PROCESSING, TOPS ELIGIBILITY, AND SUPPORT SERVICES AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES.
