LOSFA Names Assistant Executive Director of Marketing and Outreach

BATON ROUGE – David E. Roberts has joined the staff of the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance (LOSFA) as the new Assistant Executive Director of Marketing and Outreach. Roberts first day on the job was January 7. His duties will include executive oversight of the agency's Public Information, Publications and School/Lender Services Divisions.

A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Roberts worked in Philadelphia, Pa. for the last 13 years. He was a Regional Manager for the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency for five years, where he focused on increasing awareness of the agency's programs via outreach to schools, colleges, state agencies and community groups.

Roberts said he hopes to bring his expertise to "increase awareness of the agency throughout the state, so that we are the trusted advisors when students think of financial assistance."
