TOPICS: Updated GO Grant Allocations for 2009-2010 AY

An additional \$10M in GO Grant funding has been appropriated for academic year 2009-2010. This increases the GO Grant 2009-2010 budget from \$24,226,000 to \$34,226,000. The purpose of this communication is to provide the revised 2009-2010 allocation figures which includes the additional \$10M in funding. These allocations are based upon the proportion of each school's on-time billing to the total appropriation of \$34,226,000. LTC amounts will be allocated at the system level.

You are reminded that there have been changes to the GO Grant eligibility criteria, award amount, and distribution procedure for academic year 2009-2010 as outlined in Student Financial Aid Bulletins S2009-6 (Revised GO Grant Distribution Procedure Due to Anticipated Funding Shortfall) and S2009-7 (Calculation of Full Time, Half Time, and Less Than Half Time GO Awards). These criteria will remain in effect. For your convenience, these bulletins are also posted under the "Information Center" link on LOSFA's website at www.osfa.state.la.us.

Schools should submit bills to LOSFA timely, but the final deadline for submission is March 24, 2010. Bills submitted that exceed your campus allocation will be rejected. It will be the school's responsibility to track and package students according to their allocation.

Unallocated amounts remaining after the March 24 deadline will be redistributed following a methodology similar to that used for LEAP funds.
