TOPICS: Summer 2011 Go Grant

Go Grant billing for the 2010-2011 Fall, Winter and Spring semesters/terms was completed May 19, 2011. The balance of the Go Grant allocation will be available for Summer 2011 Go Grant Awards.

Schools that responded with a count of eligible summer awards will receive an allocation sufficient to award those students. Based on the estimate of 6,750 eligible students, the remaining Go Grant allocation will result in an award of \$297.00.

The following explains the methodology used to determine Go Grant summer award recipients.

Summer Go Grant Methodology: In order for a student to be eligible for a summer Go Grant award, he/she must:

- 1. Have received a Go Grant award for at least one semester/term (fall, winter or spring) during the 2010-11 academic year;
- 2. Receive a Pell Grant during summer of 2011; and
- 3. Have a balance remaining of the maximum \$2,000 Go Grant annual award.

Summer Billing Deadlines: The billing deadlines are imperative because of fiscal year end.

Submit Go Grant payment requests to LOSFA as soon as possible but no later than <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>July 13</u>, <u>2011</u>. Late billing requests will NOT be accepted.

The deadline for submitting <u>corrections</u> to summer session billing errors is <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>July 27, 2011</u>. Late billing corrections will NOT be accepted.
